The funding would be used to purchase ingredients and associated supplies for a cooking activity that the Farm to Table Cooking Class/Club is leading. This club is an approved club at Cholla and this activity is being led by an after school club that is open to all students enrolled at Cholla. It is optional and not for credit at all.
