Very transient population with some who come and go regularly. Some leave at this point because of grades to try a smaller school. Some credit recovery schools are better for some students. Now is the time students stop coming to school, and get dropped after 10 days. Drop is biggest in freshman class. High School Hoppers - they move every semester or so because of behavior problems. Family struggles play a big role as some can't afford transportation or move in with other families. Losing 5-6 per week. Perez: • Honor roll assembly in the library tomorrow. • Powder and glitter and flour thrown out at the assembly. Students were suspended. Not a tradition. • End of the semester is coming in 6 weeks. • Homecoming was great. Spirit week went well. Kids dressed up, except for grade level colors. Decorating contest was fun. Student made posters and tickets. AVID helped too with banners and posters. Theater made panels for the dance and pep rally. Mr. Jimenez was the DJ, and did a great job. Mariachi, band, JROTC, Ms. Hoy all participated. Non-gendered royalty attempted, and students seemed to like it. Need to get more royalty participation. Game was fun. Dance was attended by 450 students, including 40 who bought tickets at the door. Student council raised a lot of money (\$5800 Gross) to be able to sponsor school spirit later in the year.
