



Items to be discussed will include the following:

1. Interscholastic Athletics – Phases and Student Participation

*Mr. Armenta asked Mr. Rasool to brief the Council on interscholastic athletics and building operations. Mr. Rasool began by advising the Council that we are now in Phase Three, meaning our students can begin competing with other schools. There will be no visitors allowed for either practice or games, no student access to the locker rooms, and no District-provided transportation. He noted that while non-contact sports (volleyball, cross-country, and golf) have already started competing, football is now scheduled to being on Nov. 6 (at Tucson High), then the following week (Nov. 13) vs. Pueblo. There will be a meeting of football team parents this coming Saturday. Mr. Rasool also added that all student athletes MUST remain on remote learning when the rest of the campus transitions to hybrid learning.*

*Regarding operations, Mr. Rasool said that the remodeling/repainting of the Commons is nearly complete. He stated that the District has committed to spending some \$7 million on repainting/remodeling projects on our campus – many of which will continue throughout the year. In terms of the potential for us to begin to re-open to students on the hybrid learning model, he feels that we will be ready to do that as safely as possible.*

2. Cholla High School’s Proposed Hybrid Model

*Mr. Armenta shared and spoke about two different models of the hybrid learning schedules, which will be presented to the faculty during 10/28/20 Staff Development. He shared two different proposed schedules, stating that the Faculty will be invited to provide input during tomorrow’s (10/28/20) Staff Development meeting.*

VI. Information on Family Engagement: Ms. Ingram ..... Discussion

Student Enrollment numbers (including Learning Centers, In-Person and Remote Learning)

*Ms. Ingram briefed the Council on the likely vote (later this evening) by the Governing Board to begin hybrid learning on Thursday, November 12, 2020. Ms. Ingram noted that parents all need to designate a choice in ParentVue, letting us know whether or not they will be prepared to send their students back to the Cholla HS campus for limited in-person (hybrid) classes. She stated that of the parents who’ve responded so far, approximately two-thirds have selected the option for their students to continue remote learning, while the remaining third say that they’re ready to send students back. She added that if this ratio continues to hold, we will not be forced to divide students into two different co-horts, which would make planning quite a bit more complicated.*



VII. 2020-2021 Student Registration & Master Schedule: Ms. Adams ..... **Discussion**

- 1. AZ Department of Education (ADE) October 30<sup>th</sup> virtual visit

*Ms. Adams discussed the upcoming virtual “walk-through” by representatives of the Arizona Department of Education (ADE), scheduled to occur this Friday (October 30, 2020) – mostly in math and English classes.*

- 2. 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Benchmark Data (with PowerPoint)

*Ms. Adams shared data from our recent round of Benchmark testing – the results of which were somewhat disappointing.*

*Returning to our original schedule (3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month) puts our next meeting at November 17, 2020. Ms. Ingram advised the Council that there is a Family Engagement Team meeting scheduled to begin at 5:00 on that day; Ms. Adams advised the Council that there is also another Governing Board meeting scheduled for later that night. Because the following Tuesday (Nov. 24) is just one day before the Thanksgiving break, it was agreed that we should still meet on Tuesday, Nov. 17 – but with an earlier start time.
